

CAMPUS WEAR and Coordinated Attire Guidelines

We recognize that school is essentially a learning environment where a certain degree of structure is not only needed, but very desirable due to the business of learning. A school's guidelines for student attire should reflect this desired learning environment balanced with age-appropriateness.

All clothing may be purchased through either *School Closet* or a local merchant.

Included below are the **REVISED** guidelines for daily school attire.

GIRLS' ATTIRE:		
Skirts/Jumpers	Grades K-12	Navy, khaki, black (pleated or straight) or CCA plaid. Not to exceed two inches above the knee (including slits).
Pants	Grades K-12	Navy, khaki, or black traditional/dress pants (must be hemmed). No "cargo" or "painter" style or other leg embellishments. Must fit in a modest way; no "skinnies".
Shirts/blouses	Grades K-12	Oxford: solid colors, long/short sleeves (no emblems/embellishments) Blouse: round, Peter Pan collar style; solid colors, long/short sleeves Knit polo or turtlenecks: solid colors, long/short sleeves (no emblems/embellishments)
Sweaters/vests	Grades K-12	Traditional cardigan, V-neck or crewneck pullover, and sweater vest in solid colors coordinating with tops and pants. A shirt/blouse (listed above) must be worn under a sweater.
Socks, tights	Grades K-12	Matching colors to coordinate with bottoms/tops. Leg wear should not be layered. Only solid-colored socks/stockings are to be worn with plaid skirts and jumpers. Leggings are not included as acceptable attire.
Nylons	Grades 7-12	Plain, solid, matching colors to coordinate with attire.
Jewelry	Grades K-12	Girls may wear rings, watches, bracelets, necklaces and earrings. The only <i>pierced</i> jewelry permitted are earrings.
Shoes	Grades K-12	Traditional outdoor shoes with enclosed toe that coordinates with attire. Slippers, boots, "croc" type footwear are not acceptable for regular school wear. Heels/soles should not exceed two inches in height. Athletic shoes must be tied/enclosed.

BOYS' ATTIRE:		
Pants	Grades K-12	Navy, khaki, or black traditional/dress pants (must be hemmed). No "cargo" or "painter" style or other leg embellishments. Must fit in a modest way; no "skinnies".
Shirts	Grades K-12	Oxford: solid colors, long/short sleeves (no emblems/embellishments) Knit polo or turtlenecks: solid colors, long/short sleeves (no emblems/embellishments)
Sweaters/vests	Grades K-12	Traditional cardigan, V-neck or crewneck pullover, and sweater vest in solid colors coordinating with tops and pants. A turtleneck, oxford, or polo shirt must be worn under a sweater.
Socks	Grades K-12	Matching colors to coordinate with bottoms/tops
Hair	Grades K-12	Must be kept clean and well groomed. Hair must be off the collar. No designs should be shaven into the hair. Extreme hairstyles will be addressed individually.
Facial Hair	Grades 7-12	Boys must be clean-shaven at all times. Beards, goatees, or shadow looks are not permitted. Sideburns may not extend below the bottom of the ear.
Jewelry	Grades K-12	Boys may wear rings, watches, wristbands, and necklaces.
Shoes	Grades K-12	Traditional outdoor shoes with enclosed toe that coordinates with attire. Heels/soles should not exceed two inches in height. Athletic shoes must be tied/enclosed.

MISCELLANEOUS:	
	• Hair coloring is limited to "natural" colors (brown, black, blond, auburn).
	• Hats are not included as normal, everyday attire. Headbands, coordinating with attire, may be worn by the ladies.
	• No visible (or drawn/imitated) tattoos. This also pertains to extra-curricular activities.
	• Layers may be worn underneath shirts. Layers must be solid and free from print. Colored undergarments (camis) are not to show through the outer garment.
